### **NAVIGATION HELP**

## A site that adapts to the user

The ARSER site is an adaptive web site; it is called "responsive web design". In clear, its design offers the user a comfortable consultation regardless of the screen he uses: computer (PC or Mac), tablet, smartphone, etc. because this method allows the site to adapt to any type of device in a transparent way for the user.

# The main logo

On all pages, the "ARSeR" logo, displayed at the top of the page, enables with a single click the return to the homepage of the website.

### The main Menu

The main menu located in the horizontal headband allows you to access the main sections and pages of the site. This menu is controllable by the mouse, the keyboard and the finger for touch screens.

### The footer

The footer allows you to access additional pages such as the "legal remarks" page.

### The Ariane thread

For the forums, an Ariane thread is displayed at the top of the main content. This Ariane thread allows you to locate yourself in the forum tree. It shows you the path from the Forums home page to the current page and allows you to go back into the tree.

# The search engine

On all pages, a search engine is available in the horizontal headband.

When you perform a search, the search engine of the site lists the pages that best match your expectations.

### **FEATURES OFFERED BY YOUR BROWSER**

In parallel to the help available directly on the site, this one has been designed so as to give the possibility to your browser to take full advantage of its own features.

# **Enlarging the size of the characters**

On all the pages of the site, you have the possibility of enlarging the size of the characters. If you are on PC, use the "Ctrl" + "+" key combination to increase the size of the characters. The "Ctrl" + "-" key combination allows you to reduce the size of the characters. Successive clicks on these buttons allow you to increase or decrease the size of the characters by levels. Also note that the "Ctrl" + "0" (the "zero") key combination allows you to return to the default text size. Mac users: simply replace the "CTRL" Key with the "CMD" key to perform the same actions in the above combinations.

## Keyboard navigation

This site has been designed to allow keyboard navigation on all pages.

In most cases, simply tap the TAB key on your keyboard to navigate successively from one clickable element to another clickable element in the page.

Conversely, if you want to go back in the reverse direction of playback, use the "Shift" + "tab" key combination.

### **Printing**

Keyboard users have the ability to print any page of the site by accessing the desired page and then pressing the "CTRL" + "P" keys of the keypad simultaneously if you are on PC or "cmd" + "P" If you are on Mac.

## Bookmarking

Keyboard users can bookmark any page as a favorite.

To do this, go to the desired page, then press the "CTRL" + "D" keys on your keyboard if you are on PC, CMD + D if you are on Mac.
